Below is a list of items that I accept under the various Terracycle schemes that I am on.

**PLEASE STICK TO THE LIST, IF ITS NOT LISTED WE CANNOT TAKE IT.**

**WE DO NOT TAKE** WATER FILTERS (except Aqua Optima ones) BATTERIES OR CONTACT LENSES (there are various opticians you can take contact lenses too – please do ask!) NO BABY WIPE PACKETS. No general food packaging – eg rice packets, noodles packets. No Nappies (yes, I got one of those recently!) No loo roll or nappy plastic bags!

**WE DO NOT TAKE** SALAD/FRUIT BAGS, STRETCHY PLASTIC BAGS UNLESS IT'S A BREAD BAG. NO BREAKFAST CEREAL BAGS EG MUESLI. NO YOGHURT POTS OR PLASTIC FOOD CONTAINERS OR TETRAPAK CARTONS. NO CAT LITTER BAGS. NO AEROSOLS, CANS OR GLASS. NO CARDBOARD/PAPER OR EGG BOXES! NO PEPERAMI OR FRIDGE RAIDERS PACKETS. NO INHALERS EITHER! (THESE CAN GO TO SOME PHARMACIES FOR RECYCLING). NO COAT HANGERS. Nothing with a battery or plug.

Anything that is sent that is not on this list just fills our rubbish bin!

| <p>Pet Food</p>  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All brands of wet cat and dog plastic food pouches. Washed &amp; Dried please</li> <li>All pet treat plastic packs</li> <li>All dry pet food plastic packs.</li> </ul>  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>It's important to keep these items apart from other recycling materials, please use a separate bag for them. <b>No plastic or tin foil trays. No pet food cartons (like tetrapak cartons)</b></li> <li>These need to be rinsed out, drained and kept separate from other recycling please.</li> </ul> |
| <p>Milk Bottle Tops (fundraising for Air Ambulance)</p>                  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Plastic milk bottle tops. Must have either a 2 or a 4 in the recycling triangle logo bit.</li> </ul>  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>NO Juice / Lemonade / Tonic Water / Coke / Yogurt, lids. NO white tops from long life or other milk</b></li> <li><b>No Ketchup or Mayo or metal lids</b></li> </ul>  |

| <p>Cleaning products</p>   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All trigger sprays (ie Mr Muscle/ bathroom/ kitchen/window cleaners)</li> <li>Plastic air fresheners - Any make or size.</li> <li>Plastic tops from any make of air freshener &amp; plastic packaging they come in.</li> <li>All purpose wipes and floor wipe packets</li> <li>Fabric softener tops.</li> <li>Tops, pumps and lids from any home cleaning bottle</li> <li>Tinted rigid plastic tubs used for home cleaning</li> </ul> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The cleaning bottles themselves</li> </ul>  |

| Marigold Gloves            | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Just this brand only! The gloves and the plastic packaging that they come in</li> </ul>  |  |
| Ferrero Roche              | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Box, the tray, the outer plastic wrappers, The aluminum wrappers</li> </ul>  | <b>I collect these for Village Magpies, in Rotherwick</b>  |
| Kinder Programme           | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Kinder Aluminium foil packaging</li> <li>Kinder chocolate wrappers</li> <li>Kinder rigid plastic packaging</li> <li>Kinder flexible plastic packaging</li> </ul>   | <b>Collecting for Village Magpies</b>  |

## LOCATIONS OF DROP-OFF BINS

- **Arborfield** – Poperinghe Pre-School – wheelie bin right outside their entrance for bagged up recycling. Access is available over the summer hols (I am not totally sure about weekends though, as the pre-school is in a gated compound)
- **Basingstoke** – Chineham – private address, please ask for details
- **Bracknell Open Learning Centre** – recycling bins in the foyer, available Monday to Friday 9am to 4pm – limited opening hours during lockdown, best to call them on 01344 354220 to check opening times
- **Bracknell** – Crown Wood – private address, wheelie bin outside for no contact drop offs
- **Bracknell** – Warfield – private address, wheelie bin outside, please ask for details
- **Bramshott Chase, near Hindhead** – private address, near to the Mercedes Garage, please ask for details
- **Bramley Primary School**, Bramley Lane, Bramley, RG26 5AH – available 24/7, 1 wheelie bin outside the school fence – collecting crisp packets only atm!
- **Burghfield Common** – 2 x Private addresses (please ask for any private address details)
- **Burghfield Common** – Scout Hut – wheelie bins for bagged up recycling (only available when gates are open)
- **Crowthorne** – private address, please ask for details – brown bin on driveway with recycling poster on it
- **Earley** – Earley Town Council, Radstock Lane, Earley. RG6 5UL – open weekdays 9am to 1pm and 2pm to 4.30pm. Small bin in reception but big wheelie bin also available for larger recycling bags.
- **Finchampstead** – private address, please ask for details, wheelie bin on driveway
- **Hook** – Sacred Heart Catholic Church, London Road, Hook. RG27 9LA – purple wheelie bin
- **Hook** – Band Hall Place, RG27 9HR – 1<sup>st</sup> house on left through footpath behind Boots – purple wheelie bin
- **Liphook** – private address, available on weekends only. Please ask for details
- **Lower Earley** – Trinity Church by Asda, brown wheelie bin outside the church entrance
- **Mattingley** – The Rectory, Vicarage Lane. RG27 8LF – purple wheelie bin
- **Mortimer** – private address (please ask for address details)
- **Reading** - Pink Hippo Self Storage, Bridgewater Close, off Portman Road, Reading – available Monday to Friday, 10am to 4pm (NOT available during this current lockdown)
- **Rotherwick** – Whitewater CE Primary School, RG27 9BG – purple wheelie bin
- **Rotherwick** – Rooks Farm Cottage, The Street. RG27 9BG (up the lane opposite The Coach & Horses pub)
