

Safeguarding & Wellbeing

JAG Settings are audited by our Safeguarding and Compliance Team. They are RAG rated and provided with a Setting Development Plan. We have also launched our 5 Stars of Excellence programme. Settings achieve stars for: Meet, Greet & Welcome, Structure, Routine and Set up, Programming & Activities, Engagement & Interaction and Positive Relationships.

- All policies and procedures are kept up to date and in line with Ofsted guidelines and all clubs are run to meet government legislation
- J All sites will be risk assessed by our staff
- / All staff complete a Suitability to Work with Children document annually
- All staff have 1:1 supervision termly where their continued suitability is confirmed DBS numbers for all staff are available to schools on request
- / All safeguarding concerns raised during club sessions will be dealt with through our own policies and procedures
- / All clubs follow the LSCB guidelines which are displayed on the club noticeboard
- \checkmark All children are checked in by a member of staff and checked out by named parents/carers only
- J A minimum of one member of staff on site is Paediatric First Aid trained. We encourage all staff to undertake this training
- We ask parents to provide us with our own medication onsite for their child. Any additional training required to administer medicine will be provided
- Attendance registers are provided to the club and school daily. Absence is reported immediately to Head Office and followed up
- We have insurance with Morton Michel (Childcare Specialist Insurance)- £5,000,000 Public Liability and £10,000,000 Employer's Liability
- We follow healthy eating guidelines and always offer a selection of healthy and nutritious food. All staff have a Food Safety qualification
- J All children wear high-vis jackets outside

INCLUSION OF VULNERABLE CHILDREN, SPECIAL NEEDS & DISABILITY



Our teams fully understand the importance of Inclusive and integrated practice and as a company we take pride in our commitment to Safeguarding children.

They are supported by robust policies, procedures and access to specific resources. We have specialised support staff and training available involving flexible planning/programming, supportive leadership, and conduct setting reviews. Our site teams are encouraged to set an inclusive vision, which coordinates with our support teams in all club aspects – eg: Recruitment.

We work in partnership with the school staff in supporting children who are vulnerable through appropriate and relevant information sharing and we work with parents and outside agencies for children who have additional needs or disability. JAG also supports and places equal importance to those with medical needs and English as an additional language to ensure that every childs' need is met.

MEETING DEMAND

The club capacity is defined by the core space, if demand is greater than space capacity we will work with the partner to increase the capacity of the provision by sourcing additional space/rooms and recruiting more staff to provide places.

The minimum number of children required for our provision to launch is 10 per session. Occupancy Demand forms part of the Commercial Review.





PARENT SUPPORT & FLEXIBLE PAYMENT OPTIONS





We use an online booking system called Magic Booking and each school setting has its own license.

Parents set up a Parent Account and add their children to their account this where they book and pay for their sessions. They also create an individual child account and this is where specific information is held including; collectors, passwords, Dietary and medical needs, SEN information, EHCP's or any accidents or injuries.


All new settings benefit from a 'book now pay later' commitment, so bookings for the launch date can be secured. Our flexible payment options include instalment plans that ensure a breakdown of childcare costs into manageable monthly payments allowing parents to make regular Extended School Club bookings right through until the end of term! Parents can pay with Childcare Vouchers, Childcare benefits, Working family tax credits, by credit and Debit card or by standing order.

As part of your partnership, you receive a dedicated Marketing Toolkit, produced by our in-house team. This includes electronic branded communication for your parents. You also receive a full Marketing kit to promote places onsite.

Our Team work on site prior, during and after launch to reach out to your families.
