



Uniform:

- Navy sweatshirt or cardigan **with or without** the school logo - Required
- White polo shirt or plain white shirt – optional school logo
- Navy fleece **with or without** school logo - optional
- **Grey** school trousers or shorts
- **Grey** school skirt or tunic
- **Blue and white check summer dress or playsuit**
- Socks or Tights – **Black, Grey or White** - Required
- Sensible, **plain black** shoes or plain black trainers – NO LOGO - Required
- Sensible plain black or white sandals can be worn in the summer

For PE:

- Plain T-shirt in team colour – **with or without** logo - Required
- **Navy** plain shorts or skorts – - Required
- **Navy** plain tracksuit – winter only – optional
- Suitable sports footwear - Required
- A drawstring bag to keep it in - Required

PE KIT SHOULD BE BROUGHT TO SCHOOL ON A MONDAY AND TAKEN HOME ON A FRIDAY.

Accessories:

- School Book Bag – EYFS/KS1 - optional
- Outdoor shoes or wellies - Required
- Water Bottle - Required
- Sun hats or baseball caps – optional
- Iron-on clothing name labels – Advised

Please make sure all items of clothing and shoes are clearly labelled.

Please note:

- High heels are not permitted; however, block heels or no more than 3cm can be worn
- Permitted jewellery that may be worn:
 - Small stud earrings
 - A smart and sensible wristwatch – nothing that will cause a distraction during lessons.

It has been common practice at Lamb's Lane for many years to expect that pupils will remove earrings for the duration of their PE lesson. This is for health and safety reasons and is common practice in most primary schools.

Jewellery is the responsibility of the pupil and not the school.

Hairstyles:

The school reserves the right to make a judgement on where pupils' hairstyles or hair colours are inappropriate for the school environment; however, will ensure that any such judgements do not discriminate against any pupil by virtue of their protected characteristics. Each individual pupil's scenario will be considered where any judgements on appropriateness are to be made, and parents will always have the freedom to complain via the school's Complaints Procedures Policy.

Pupils with long hair must ensure that this does not impede their vision, cover their face or provide a health and safety risk. Long hair must be completely tied up during practical lessons, e.g. during PE.

Summer Uniform:

We would like to let you know about a small change to our summer uniform. From the next academic year, our summer dress or playsuit will be changing from red check to blue check.

To allow for a smooth transition, both red and blue check dresses and playsuits will be accepted over the coming year. This means that children may continue to wear their existing red dresses while these are gradually phased out, helping to avoid unnecessary expense.

After this transition period, the blue check dress will become the standard summer uniform from September 2028. Thank you for your continued support.
