Jigsaw - Changing Me

*1 Any information that explains sexual reproduction has been removed from the lesson. The pupils will cover this as part of the science curriculum.

The word 'fertilisation' is used in the context of menstruation – 'If the egg is not fertilised, the extra lining isn't needed so it breaks up.' Any questions about how the egg is fertilised are answered with, 'That is something we will be learning about in science.'

The word 'virgin' is used in the context of menstruation worries – 'If I use tampons, am I still a virgin?' Teachers will explain the term as someone who has not had sexual intercourse, which we will learn about as part of our sexual reproduction in mammals lesson.

*2 Any information that explains sexual reproduction has been removed from the lesson. The pupils will cover this as part of the science curriculum.

*3 This lesson will not be taught as part of the PSHE curriculum. The science module 'Living things and their habitats' covers the learning objective, 'to describe the life process of reproduction in animals'. To meet this learning objective, pupils will learn about sexual reproduction in humans in their science lessons.
