Road Safety & Considerate Parking

The area outside school can get very busy at drop-off and pick-up times, and we really appreciate everyone's patience as we all work to keep our children safe.

A gentle reminder that the **drop-off zone is for quick drop-offs only**. Keeping this space clear helps the traffic flow smoothly and ensures children can arrive safely.

Please also be mindful of our neighbours by **avoiding parking across driveways or using private property to turn around**. A little extra care goes a long way in maintaining positive relationships within our community.

You'll notice **yellow zig-zag lines** outside the school entrance—these need to stay clear at all times. They give children a clear view of the road when crossing and are an important safety feature outside schools.

Finally, we kindly ask that **no vehicles use the school driveway at any point during the school day**, as this area must remain accessible and safe for pupils and staff. Anyone parking here will be asked to move.
