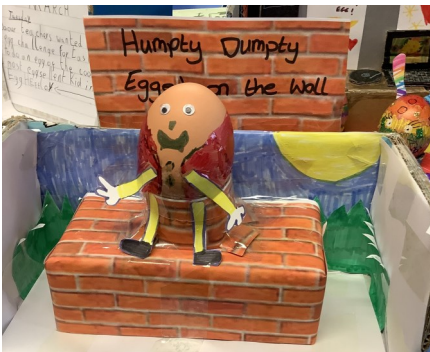
# **Egg-siting Easter Competition**

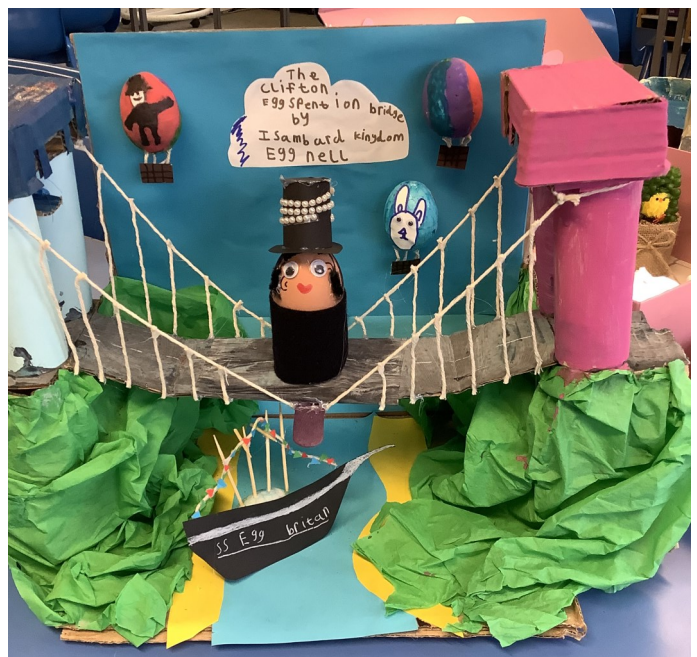
The egg can be placed within a setting but this must be no bigger than A5 (this is half of A4!).

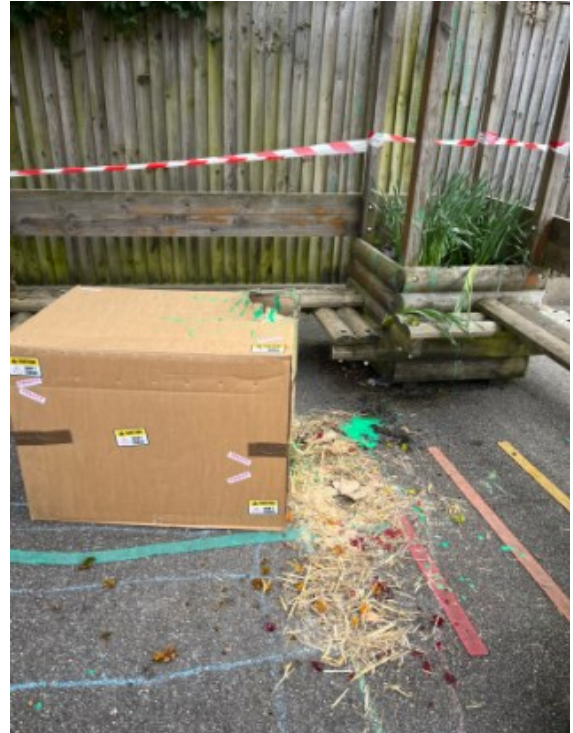
We all have high **egg-spectations** for each entry and **egg-spect** the **egg-sperience** will be a fun one!
