On Friday last week, he received a letter in the post from the Fictional Director to say thank you and a note to say they will correct it in future additions.

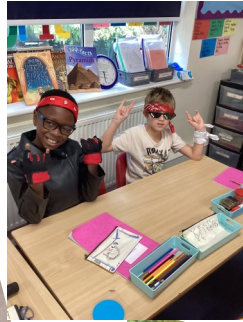
