




Read Write Inc. Phonics Parents' Meeting

And I mean everything.



## Read, Write, Inc Phonics



Children begin to learn to read using sound cards to practise single letter sounds.

Once they have learnt their sounds, they begin to blend and read simple words.

Once they are confident with blending, they begin to read storybooks and use these to help their writing.



#### How does it work?

#### **Children:**

Learn 44 sounds and matching letters.

Learn to blend sounds to read words.

Read lots of specially written books.

This is decoding.



#### How does it work?

#### **Children:**

Talk a lot about what they have read to show they understand.

Listen to and discuss other ideas to deepen understanding.

This is comprehending.




